Cheyenne Country Club Tennis

For tennis enthusiasts, we offer three lighted tennis courts and 8 pickleball courts (to be finished by spring 2025). The eleven courts together create a pleasing environment for tennis players of all ages and abilities. The Tennis Shop offers re-stringing and re-gripping services with tennis equipment available for purchase. The Tennis Shop also has loaner racquets available for use of the membership.

Experienced, certified and highly trained tennis staff professionals offer lessons, clinics and drills for beginners to tournament level players of all ages. Members enjoy this lifetime sport as they increase their playing abilities by participating in the many group, tournament and team activities promoted by the Cheyenne Country Club.

Tennis lessons either as a group or as an individual are offered with junior tennis available for your sons and daughters ages 5 to 18.



Cheyenne Country Club Swimming

Our Olympic sized zero entry swimming pool is open from Memorial Day to Labor Day each year (*weather permitting*) and offers a wonderful family recreational experience. The Cheyenne Country Club pool is fully staffed by certified lifeguards and professional swimming instructors capable of providing swimming lessons for the entire family.

Additionally, there are swim meets for the junior swimmer to compete with swimmers from the surrounding area. The pool hosts Movie Nights during the Summer giving families a pleasant evening poolside with snacks, beverages and a good film for all to enjoy.

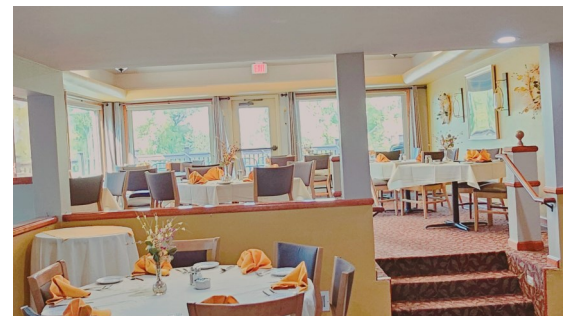

Cheyenne Country Club Membership

Membership Categories

The Cheyenne Country Club offers several membership Categories:

Full Membership (includes spouse & dependents under 25);

Includes the use of the golf course, tennis courts, swimming pool and the Clubhouse.

Initiation Fee	\$ 7,500
Monthly Dues	\$ 357

Firm/Corporate Membership (includes spouse & dependents):

Company or Corporate membership that includes the use of the golf course, tennis courts, swimming pool and Clubhouse.

Initiation Fee (first membership)	\$ 7,500
Initiation Fee (each additional membership)	\$ 7,500
Transfer Fee	\$ 300
Monthly Dues	\$ 357

Junior Membership (includes spouse & dependents);

For members 29 years of age or younger. This membership includes the use of the golf course, tennis courts, swimming pool and Clubhouse. The junior member may keep this membership for five years before upgrading to a full membership

Initiation Fee	\$ 3,750
Monthly Dues	\$ 305

Social Membership (includes spouse & dependents);

This membership includes the use of the tennis courts, swimming pool and Clubhouse. It does not include the use of the golf course.

Initiation Fee	\$ 3,750
Monthly Dues	\$ 189

Note:

All members regardless of membership type have a quarterly "use it or lose it" or "food/alcohol minimum" obligation. The current fee is \$160.00. If at the end of a quarter you have not charged the full dining room food minimum of \$160.00, the balance between what has been used and the fee will be billed to your account.
